## TRANSMISSION

A heavy duty automatic transmission has been released for the 1963 Plymouth six (6) cylinder cars when ordered for Taxi or Police service. This is essentially the TorqueFlite Transmission used on eight (8) cylinder cars with an adapter plate, a new accumulator piston spring, which changes the shift pattern to accommodate the six (6) cylinder engine.

The transmission is serviced in the same manner as the TorqueFlite Transmission on eight (8) cylinder cars, covered in the 1963 Plymouth Service Manual.

When specifying parts for this type of installation, refer to MoPar Parts Information Bulletin No. 420 dated November 14, 1962.
